1. No exact copies of other known carvers' works. Blending of styles and forms is acceptable.
2. All entries **must!!!** Be engraved or branded with the carver's initials and date carved. **Decoy must be carved within the last year.**
3. **The Best of Show decoy will remain with the O.D.C.C.A. for one year for display purposes at the Migratory Bird Center, Magee Marsh and then returned to the carver.**

All entries will be judged in one of three categories - ducks, shorebirds, and confidence including all geese, crows, songbirds, wading birds, etc... First, second, and third places will be awarded a ribbon for each category. The best of each category will then be judged against each other to determine first, second, and third best of show
