

Flat Art Contest – Any Vintage Decoy

1. Anyone can enter and you need not be a member. There are two classes – Open and Student.
2. Any fine art media may be used with the exception of photographs or computer.
3. Your entry **should not** be framed or have glass or matting.
4. Min size 8 x 10 – Max size 11 x 14.
5. Entry must be shrink-wrapped or acetate covered on cardboard.
6. Hand-carried entries must be presented to the contest chairman before 9:30AM Saturday, March 21, 2009, in the Ballroom of the Holiday Inn. **Students** (K through 12th grade) **must pick up their entries** on Sunday at 3PM
7. The winning artwork will be returned to the artist, but the ODCCA does reserve the right to have the use of the winning artwork for a future show pin, clothing items, and the covers of our rules brochure and newsletter.

There is a limit of four entries per person.

Note: When selecting your entry, keep in mind that your artwork will be used for next year’s logo. The Judges will be looking for fine art and art that will work well as logo art. Size, Color, Background and Artistic Representation are important.

The winning entry may be used on the Show Pin, T-shirts, mugs, etc... for the 33rd annual show.
